

Hello and welcome to CDH!

AP Human Geography is offered to 9th grade students and is a two trimester class, offered 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> trimesters. All 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are required to take either general level Human Geography (1 trimester) OR Advanced Placement Human Geography (2 trimesters) for their Social Studies requirement.

Students entering an AP Human Geography course should be capable of reading and comprehending texts written at the college level. In addition, AP Human Geography students have strong organizational and problem-solving skills.

Advanced Placement (AP) courses give high school students the opportunity to take a college level class, with the potential to earn college credit while still in high school. This AP course presents high school students with the curricular equivalent of an introductory college-level course in human geography or cultural geography. Students will take the National AP Human Geography test in May and their score on the exam will determine if the College Board recommends them for college credit.
