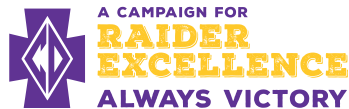

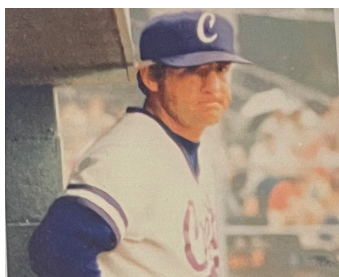

DEFINING A LEGEND

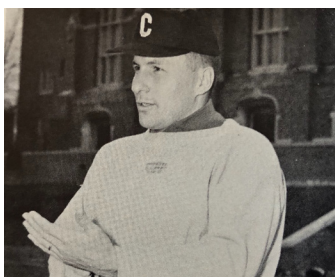
This distinction honors the lifetime achievement of Cretin-Derham Hall coaches who exemplify high standards of coaching success, show integrity on and off the field, demonstrate leadership and dedication to the development of each student-athlete’s mind, body and spirit and has been inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame.

To honor the numerous Cretin-Derham Hall coaches who embody the qualities of a Legend, we are inviting donors to the **Always Victory** Capital Campaign to make a contribution in a coach’s honor to recognize them in our new meeting room space. We are working to honor the following Legends but encourage contributions to any CDH coach considered a Legend.



Dennis Denning '62

Coach Dennis Denning led Cretin’s and CDH’s baseball teams from 1978-1994. Coach Denning started at Cretin as a physical education teacher and later served as athletic director. He was inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 2007.



Len Horyza

Coach Len Horyza was the head basketball coach at Cretin and CDH from 1965-1995. He also served as head football coach for the 1966, 1967 and 1968 seasons and assistant football coach for many seasons and a math teacher for 35 years. He was inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 1996.



William "Ted" Joyce '46

Coach Ted Joyce was the head hockey coach at Cretin High School from 1952-1971 and assistant football coach from 1954-1984. Coach Joyce spent time in the classroom as a social studies teacher from 1955-1985 and served as the school’s Alumni Director from 1985-1990. He was inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 1990.



Rich Kallok

Coach Rich Kallok coached 24 seasons (1981-2004) as assistant coach, head coach or co-head football coach at Cretin and CDH. Coach Kallok also served the school as a teacher, track and basketball coach, athletics director, assistant principal and principal. He was inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 2012.



Jim O'Neill '74

Coach Jim O'Neill coached hockey and baseball at Cretin and CDH for 38 years. Coach O'Neill has held several positions at CDH, including assistant to the athletic director, but his favorite job has been taking care of the baseball fields for close to 30 years. He will be inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 2024.



Mal Scanlan '61

Coach Mal Scanlan was the head football coach from 1983-1988, co-head coach from 1990-1992 and returned to CDH as assistant coach from 1998-2021. Coach Scanlan served CDH in various roles for 50 years including teacher, development officer and director. He was inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 2008.



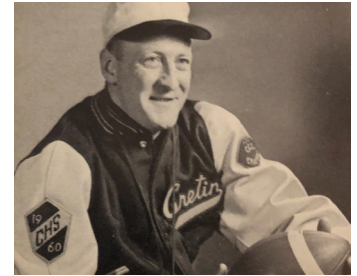
Mike Scanlan '70

Coach Mike Scanlan coached football at Cretin and CDH for 30 years. Coach Scanlan also served the school as a student counselor and teacher. He was inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 2022.



Lynn Strand

Coach Lynn Strand served at Derham Hall as a teacher, coach and athletic director beginning in 1976, and stayed on at the newly-merged CDH through 1989. At Derham Hall and CDH, she coached gymnastics, cross country, track and field, volleyball and softball. She was inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 2012.



Tom Warner

Coach Tom Warner served as the head football coach and the head baseball coach at Cretin High School from 1956-1966. Coach Warner also taught biology. He will be inducted into the CDH Athletic Hall of Fame in 2024.
