Students will study the distribution of human activities at global and regional scales, and the causes and consequences of those distributions. Specific topics covered will include population, globalization, natural resources, agriculture, economic activity, urban and rural settlements, and cultural phenomena. Students will also learn about the tools that human geographers use to describe the world, and gain a basic understanding of how those tools are applied.
