Current Vocal Ensembles open to 9th Graders at Cretin-Derham Hall:

Concert Choir - Concert Choir is a year-long course and it is the recommended option for freshmen interested in singing at CDH. This non-auditioned ensemble is open to all CDH students regardless of musical ability, experience, or voice part. In this rehearsal-based class, we will focus primarily on building musicianship, developing healthy vocal technique and tone, and expanding musical literacy. We put on several concerts each year, as well as participate in music festivals and trips; in 2026, we have plans to visit New York City! Previous trips include San Diego and San Antonio. (Note: it is possible to fit Choir in your schedule, even if you are also in JROTC! Talk to Ms. Schuster or your counselor to learn more. There are scheduling alternatives available to alleviate scheduling issues, including 1 excused PE credit if you take Choir for all 4 years.)

Music Ministry - This is a non-auditioned extra-curricular group that meets once a week during Flex Time with the purpose of preparing music to sing at school Masses and prayer services. This is a low-commitment group that is focused on sharing our musical gifts to serve God and our school community. Participants include both singers and instrumentalists. We welcome everyone, regardless of musical experience!

Purple Reign A Cappella - This is an auditioned, extra-curricular singing club that is intended to be a higher level ensemble for those looking for an additional musical challenge. While most members are in grades 10-12 and have taken at least 1 year of Choir, it is open to all to audition. This group focuses on unaccompanied pop repertoire (think Pitch Perfect!) and vocal jazz.
