Cretin-Derham Hall seeks candidates for the position of Head Football Coach. Position begins in May 2025 and continues through November 2025. The salary range is \$8,500 to \$11,000, and is commensurate with experience. This is not a benefit-eligible position.

Lead a comprehensive football program and coaching staff that develops students in grades nine through twelve with a focus on individual skill and character development, staff alignment, and internal and external communication. As a part of the entire school and Athletic Department, this program needs to complement the many offerings so that students are successful academically, physically and spiritually.
